



Congratulations on being accepted at Trinity College. This email is about your subjects.

This email is for February Main students – your Confirmation of Enrolment will say: Trinity College Foundation Studies February (Main) [073413G].

You will also need your Confirmation of Enrolment to locate your 'Provider Student Id' – your student number.

We have delayed the start of classes until all students can show a two week period of being healthy after arriving in Australia - to try and be as safe as possible.

This means that Orientation activities will start on the 17<sup>th</sup> of February – so long as students can show they have been in Australia for two weeks.

Other classes have been changed, so you will still get the same amount of classes in the course.

To choose your subjects, it will be through this email.

At Trinity, you will study:

- compulsory (core) subjects – English, and History of Ideas
- subjects that you choose – that is, elective subjects.

We are asking you to tell us which three elective subjects you would like to study at Trinity. This will help us to plan a timetable for you and for your teachers.
