Klingner Scholarship Application 2020

Purpose: The Klingner Scholarship was founded in 1975, in memory of Harold Edgar Klingner, to support members of the St Peter's Guild of Servers or "other suitable candidates" in training for Holy Orders.

Applications are welcome from those who are presently, or soon to be, training for the diaconate and priesthood at one of the following theological colleges: Trinity College, Melbourne; St Barnabas College, Adelaide; or St Francis College, Brisbane.

Amount: Klingner Scholars are usually awarded \$8,000 for one year with the right to reapply. As a scholarship, this amount is tax-exempt.

Criteria: it is expected that the candidate will:

- be a member of the St Peter's Eastern Hill Guild of Servers, and on the parish roll of St Peter's Eastern Hill, **or** on the parish roll of another parish, generally within the Anglo-Catholic tradition.
- contribute to St Peter's Eastern Hill parish in some substantive agreed way over the course of the year of study.
- have been accepted by the Diocese of Melbourne, or another Australian Anglican Diocese, as a candidate in training for Holy Orders, or be actively involved in a Diocesan discernment program.
- be enrolled for one or more papers per semester at one of the three theological colleges listed above.

Application Process: the applicant must submit the following:

- Completed application form.
- Letter of application addressed to the Klingner Trustees. The letter should contain a brief statement providing biographical information (e.g. church involvement, brief work history) and a summary of future plans.
- Letter of nomination from the applicant's parish priest or a member of the Anglican Church with significant knowledge of the applicant's experience and church involvement.
- Academic transcript of previous degree(s) or other tertiary study undertaken.
- A 500 word essay addressing the topic:
"Anglo-Catholicism: 2020 and Beyond"

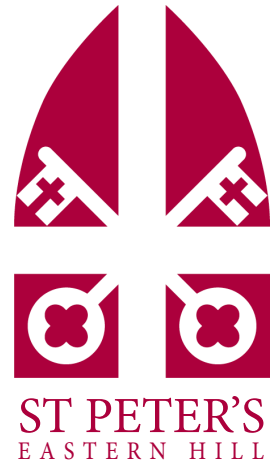
Deadline: Klingner scholarship applications are to be submitted by **Friday 15th November 2019**.
