When applying for a Trinity College scholarship, applicants do not apply for a particular scholarship; if successful, candidates will be assigned accordingly based on their suitability.

All information contained in your scholarship application will remain strictly confidential. All forms must be digitally completed. Scholarship applications are due for all students before **15 October** every year.
