

Under 18 DIAC Welfare Declaration

Welfare declaration for students under the age of 18 who do <u>NOT</u> require a Trinity College CAAW (Confirmation of Appropriate Accommodation and Welfare)

The Australian Department of Immigration and Citizenship (DIAC) regulations under the ESOS Act 2007 require that students under the age of 18 have accommodation, support and general welfare arrangements in place when studying in Australia.
Complete this form to advise Trinity College that you will be living with a parent, legal custodian or relative and do NOT require Trinity College to issue the CAAW document. In this case, accommodation arrangements must be confirmed directly with DIAC. This form must be fully completed and emailed or faxed to the Registrations Department with a fully completed Invoice and Acceptance page of your Trinity College Letter of Offer and notification of payment.
