



REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

In 2014 I was once again humbled by the generosity and support of the Trinity College community.

This support is greatly appreciated and is allowing the College to continue to provide an educational experience that can be compared with the best in the world.

We have more scholarships than ever before. We are continually upgrading and maintaining our beautiful historic buildings, and are well on our way to funding the new academic and cultural precinct. The internationally recognised Trinity Choir continues to receive support, and our General Endowment continues to grow. We are leading the way with our commitment to Indigenous education, and are attracting outstanding visiting scholars.

In 2014 we had 606 donors making combined contributions of \$2,495,000 in cash, with a further \$475,000 pledged

for future years. These donors are recognised in the Donors listings in this publication.

Fundraising figures alone don't reveal the investment in future potential giving.

The fundraising efforts were supported by fantastic efforts in donor and alumni engagement.

In 2014, the Advancement team had over 300 face-to-face meetings with approximately 400 alumni and friends of the College, where the activities and projects we are involved with at Trinity were shared, and their support was asked for. (In 2013, we tallied 260 face-to-face meetings.)

Furthermore, there were 41 events, in four different states, which were attended by over 1,900 people.

Over 12 months our College LinkedIn membership grew by 50% from 1,000 to 1,500, providing us with a long-term avenue for staying in touch with alumni.

This year we also changed the system by which we send our E-News bulletins, giving us an opportunity to measure reader engagement. In 2014 we had an open rate of 48% (the percentage of people who open their E-News email). We do not have 2013 figures to compare this with, but the average in the education sector sits around 24% (the Economics and Commerce Faculty at the University of Melbourne has an open rate of 20%). This suggests that our readers – largely residential College alumni – remain highly engaged with the College over time.

Late last year we also started measuring the average monthly visitors to our website. In 2013 it was 24,500; for 2014 we averaged 32,400 per month.

In May, the Gateway building was featured in various University of Melbourne publications, including the 'Voice' magazine in *The Age*, the University's Alumni news, and the campaign publication 'Believe'.

Two highlights stand out for me during the year. The speeches made by the scholarship recipients at the Founders & Benefactors Dinner were so honest and heartfelt that they actually brought a tear to the eye.

And then a much smaller event we held for the donors to the Gibson Scholarship, where

we heard from Hussain Alamein about his incredible journey having to flee Iraq, spending 18 months in detention on Nauru. He arrived in Shepparton, not being able to speak English. After struggling at first, he flourished at school and became school captain. Thanks solely to receiving a scholarship, he was able to accept a place studying Biomedicine at the University of Melbourne. Hearing his story was incredibly moving.

Certainly, the Foundation's achievements in 2014 represent a truly wonderful group effort from the entire College community.

I would like to sincerely thank the members of the Advancement team and the members of the Executive Committee for their support

and guidance during the year in the role. Thank you also to the former Warden, Andrew MacGowan; Campbell Bairstow in his roles as Acting Warden and then Provost; the Senior Management Team; and Charles Sitch, the Chairman of the Foundation.

I am very excited about 2015 and about helping to set the College up for another 142 years.

MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN

It is pleasing to report that philanthropic support for the College continued to grow in 2014.

The Foundation supports the College in its vision to provide an educational experience that rivals the best university colleges in the world. The strength of the Foundation in recent times has given us confidence that this vision for the College is shared by our many contributors.

In 2014 we had over 600 donors, making combined contributions of just under \$2.5 million in cash, with a further \$475,000 pledged for future years.

This was the fifth highest amount raised in a year since the Foundation was formed in 1983.

We also continued to drive engagement with the College.

A key to our future philanthropic success is to broaden the donor base, and on that note the fundraising efforts were supported by fantastic efforts in donor and alumni engagement.

There were two highlights for me during the year:

- At the Founders & Benefactors Dinner we were treated to two very moving speeches by scholarship recipients. It reminded me of the important work we are doing to raise the funds required to give these wonderful students an opportunity to succeed.

- The excitement we have generated around the new Gateway building has been significant. This landmark building will exemplify the commitment that the University of Melbourne and Trinity College share in furthering the education of all our students, and we are proud that donors are sharing this vision with us.

It is important to acknowledge the contribution of the Executive Committee in achieving this result.

I would particularly like to thank Robin Campbell for her service on the committee. Robin stepped down in December, and her contributions – including her own financial support as well as bringing others in – have been greatly appreciated.

I would also like to thank the former Warden, Andrew MacGowan, as well as Campbell Bairstow, in his roles as Acting Warden and then Provost, and the Advancement team lead by Scott Charles. A truly wonderful group effort from the entire College community.

I am very excited about the momentum we currently have and seeing that build again in 2015.

FUNDS' PERFORMANCE

The Foundation received \$1.9 million in donations in 2014, and earned a further \$1.7 million of income from its investments.

The Foundation uses an independent investment advisor (Jana Investment Advisers Pty Ltd) to help manage its growing pool of assets. The assets of the Foundation are currently invested in a mixture of Australian and international equities, debt and liquid securities. The Foundation does not invest directly, but uses recommended fund managers specialising in the various market segments.

The weightings of the various segments determine a benchmark portfolio return against which the results of the investment managers are measured. The overall objective is to maintain the corpus of the Foundation funds in real terms so inflation does not diminish the purchasing power of the endowed funds over time. The investment return target of the Foundation is CPI plus 5%. As a Public Ancillary Fund, the Foundation is required to distribute at least 4% of its net assets each year.


For 2014 the returns were as follows:

At the end of 2014, the Foundation had a total of \$29 million in assets under management, and its net assets were \$29.9 million.
